In the afternoon a workshop will be held to make soap, for teachers and students, in which we can observe the entire process of preparation until obtaining the 100% ecological bar of soap.

The second day the students of the School, perform dances and songs with the students disguise and with masks included within the Carnival party, in the city of Malaga.

Visit to the Botanical Garden of La Concepción a beautiful and lush garden, currently considered a Cultural Interest Site. The main purpose of this garden is to preserve and improve the historic garden

and build a garden where plant collections have educational and scientific purposes.

Third day, visit the Nature Hall Las Contadoras, in the Natural Park of the Montes de Málaga. We will know wild species of our nature, protected natural spaces and an introduction to the Montes de Málaga Natural Park. After a brief stop we begin the workshops of traces, tracks and signs of vertebrates, in addition to a route guided by the Mirador Vázquez.

In the afternoon and inside the park we make a workshop on aromatic plants and vertebrate observation. The different workshops intends to act as a revitalizer of environmental education in Malaga. This park is a Protected Area by the Junta de Andalucía, since it is a space rich in flora and fauna with a very unique landscape idiosyncrasy that provides enormous pine masses.

On the fourth day, visit the Diputación de Málaga that will show us a tour of the province with a sample of the most characteristic with special emphasis on the environment.
